It is my pleasure to introduce some exciting changes in the organizational structure of the Connecticut Veterans Organization! We have been in the process of applying for 501c3 status and we expect to mail the application to the IRS on 21 December 2009. In compliance with our Incorporation as a non profit, and our application for 501c3, our charter will be dissolved into our bylaws effective 16 January 2010, at our annual meeting. The initial charter will be signed at our December members meeting on 19 December 2009, which will be included in our application. We have has to take our conflict of interest policy from our charter and create its own document, as it is not part of our bylaws. Our bylaws will now have more detailed organizational information and shall be easier to follow, and be in a more legally binding form.
